–King Kauluma Combined School, Iyampingana Constituency, Oshikoto Region

(Four classrooms and a storeroom worth around 969,000 NAD)

18 November 2021

-Donatus Primary School, Otjiwarongo Constituency, Otjozondjupa Region
(Four classrooms and a storeroom worth around 875,000 NAD)
