JAPANESE FILMS COME TO ONE AFRICA TELEVISION

Starting on the 31 May 2022, two Japanese films will be broadcasted on One Africa Television. This is part of the agreement that was signed between One Africa Television and Japan Foundation in collaboration with Embassy of Japan. Every Tuesday, Saturday and Sunday viewers of One Africa can enjoy Japanese animation (anime) and documentary series. The shows will be broadcasted on One Africa TV on DSTV Channel 284, GoTV 90 and DSTV Now. The two films are:

- Black Jack (Animation): Black Jack is a notorious unlicensed doctor who contracts to perform surgery in return for large sums of money. Nevertheless, he is a brilliant surgeon with top notch skills. They even say his scalpel skills are superhuman. With Pinoko, his small partner, Black Jack tackles a succession of difficult cases using his masterly skills with the scalpel. The anime will premiere on Tuesday, 31 May at 07h00 am, and will repeat on Saturday, 4 June at 14h30.
- Explore Japan 2021(Documentary): Japan continues to thrive as it incorporates cultural elements of music, fashion, cuisine, sports, arts and science from around the world. People's encounters trigger the fusion of Japan's and the world's diverse cultures, unceasingly producing a myriad of new phenomena and events. This series will feature how various cultures in modern Japan and overseas blend together and influence each other. The documentary series will premiere on Sunday, 5 June at 17h00.
