The Japanese government has aided total of 226,000 US dollars in 2021 in order to carry out the "Emergency response to improve livelihood, food security, and nutrition in the regions in Namibia damaged by the Desert Locusts"

Ms. Farayi expressed appreciation to the aid from the Japanese government, as it is difficult for the UNFAO in Namibia to secure budgets for projects in Namibia, classified as a middle and high-income countries, from the United Nations headquarters. Ms. Farayi also expects a further partnership with the Japanese government in order to protect lives and to support self-reliance of those who are facing hardships in escaping poverty.
