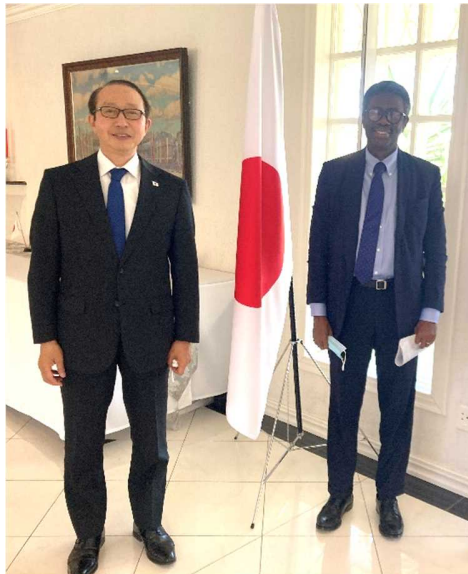


Meeting with Dr. Charles Sagoe-Moses, WHO Representative to Namibia (4 August 2022)

On 4 August 2022, Ambassador Nishimaki invited Dr. Charles Sagoe-Moses, Representative of World Health Organisation (WHO) Namibia, to his residence to exchange views on the WHO's contribution to preventing the COVID-19 infection in Namibia and the recent outbreak of monkeypox in Europe.

During the discussion, Dr. Sagoe-Moses expressed his gratitude to Japan for being one of the biggest donors to the WHO in Namibia, where because of its classification as an upper-middle income country with UN agencies have a limited budget.
