On 6 February 2023, Ambassador and Mrs Nishimaki paid a courtesy visit to H.E. Dr. Sam Nujoma, the Founding President of the Republic of Namibia and Father of the Namibian nation. The courtesy visit was held at his private residence at Etunda Trust Farm, which is located in Otavi District, Otjozondjupa Region, in Central-Eastern Namibia.

Ambassador Nishimaki introduced the Japanese Government's development cooperation assistance to Namibia to H.E. Dr. Nujoma, who spoke about his nation-building efforts during his three consecutive terms as President from 1990 to 2005, following Namibia's independence on 21st March 1990. H.E.
