

## Ambassador Nishimaki's visit to Liswani III Primary School in Zambezi Region (March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2024)

On March 2, 2024, Ambassador Nishimaki visited Liswani III Primary School in Zambezi Region, where a new school building (4 classrooms and 1 storage room) will be constructed under the FY2023 Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects: GGP (grant amount: US\$72,407). Ambassador Nishimaki met the school principal, Ms. Norah Mubila, and inspected the school. Principal Mubila expressed her appreciation to Ambassador Nishimaki for the construction of the new classrooms. Since 1997, the Japanese government has constructed approximately 300 classrooms in Namibia under the GGP scheme. This school is located in one of the wildlife conservancies in Zambezi Region. And in the past, some elephants and lions appeared in this school area.
