

## Ambassador Nishimaki's visit to Sauyemwa Junior Primary School in Kavango East Region (March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2024)

On March 20, 2024, Ambassador Nishimaki visited Sauyemwa Junior Primary School in Kavango East Region, where a new school building (4 classrooms and 1 storage room) will be constructed under the FY2023 Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects: GGP (grant amount: US\$52,134). Ambassador Nishimaki met the school principal, Ms. Regina Haingura and toured the school. Principal Haingura expressed her appreciation to Ambassador Nishimaki for the construction of the new classrooms. Since 1997, the Japanese government has constructed approximately 300 classrooms in Namibia under the GGP scheme. The Sauyemwa Junior Primary School is a large school with more than 2,200 learners enrolled, and due to a lack of classrooms, the school requested support through the GGP.
