On March 21, 2024, Ambassador Nishimaki attended the Namibian Independence Day Celebrations held in the Zambezi Region in the far North Eastern town of Katima Mulilo.

It was the first time since Independence in 1990 that these celebrations were held in the Zambezi Region and also the first time that H.E. Nangolo Mbumba is presiding over the Independence Day celebrations as President of Namibia.
