

Ambassador Nishimaki's attendance at the handover ceremony for the new school building at Ontanda Primary School in Omusati Region (10th October 2024)

On 10 October 2024, Ambassador Nishimaki attended a handover ceremony at Ontanda Primary School, Tsandi Circuit, Omusati Region where one new school building (with four classrooms and a storage) was constructed by the Japanese Government (officially it's called "the 2022 Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP)") and handed over the building to Hon. Andreas Shintama, Chairperson of Omusati Regional Council representing the Namibian Government. The construction of the new building at the school has enabled about 140 learners who previously studied in temporary classrooms made of corrugated iron and makeshift poles, to learn in a conducive environment. Additionally, the Japanese Government funded the repair of 35 desks and 80 chairs for learners that were severely damaged and granted four new desks for teachers at the school.
