On 7 November 2024, Ambassador Nishimaki attended a handover ceremony at Chiristoph Ngatjizeko Primary School, Otjinene Constituency, Omaheke Region where one new school building (with three classrooms and a storage) was constructed by the Japanese Government (officially it's called "the 2023 Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP)") and handed over the building to Hon. Faustina Caley, Deputy Minister of Basic Education, Arts and Culture, representing the Namibian Government. The construction of one new school building at Chiristoph Ngatjizeko Primary School has improved the primary education environment in Otjinene Constituency, allowing 120 students who had previously studied in the afternoon to attend morning classes.
