On 22 November 2024, Ambassador Nishimaki, together with Dr. Qingyun Diao, FAO Country Representative, visited beneficiary household in Musese Village, Kavango West Region supported under FAO's Japan Supplementary Budget FAO project titled "Emergency response to enhance resilience and mitigate climate-induced impacts on livelihoods, food and nutrition security of the most vulnerable household in Namibia" (Grant Amount: USD 758,916, Implementation Period: March 2024 - March 2025). Ambassador Nishimaki recognized the need for assistance when he visited this household about two years ago because this household was headed by an unemployed single mother who was raising 3 children with disabilities and no income source. Through FAO, the household now received a chicken house, 100 chickens, chicken feed, feeders, drinkers, and a water tank.
