

**Courtesy Visit to Hon.Lt. Gen. (rtd) Sebastian Ndeitunga, Governor of Ohangwena Region by Ambassador Nishimaki and Ms. Shafudah WFP Deputy Country Representative

On December 4–6 2024, Ambassador Nishimaki travelled to Ohangwena Region with Ms. Ericah Shafudah, Deputy Country Representative of the United Nations World Food Programme (WFP) and paid a courtesy visit on December 4 to Hon. Sebastian Ndeitunga the Governor of Ohangwena Region. Ambassador Nishimaki informed Hon. Ndeitunga that the purpose of the visit to the region was to attend the launch event of the urgent food distribution program that the Government of Japan is implementing with WFP, and to visit retail shop and beneficiary household in the region where food distribution is taking place.
