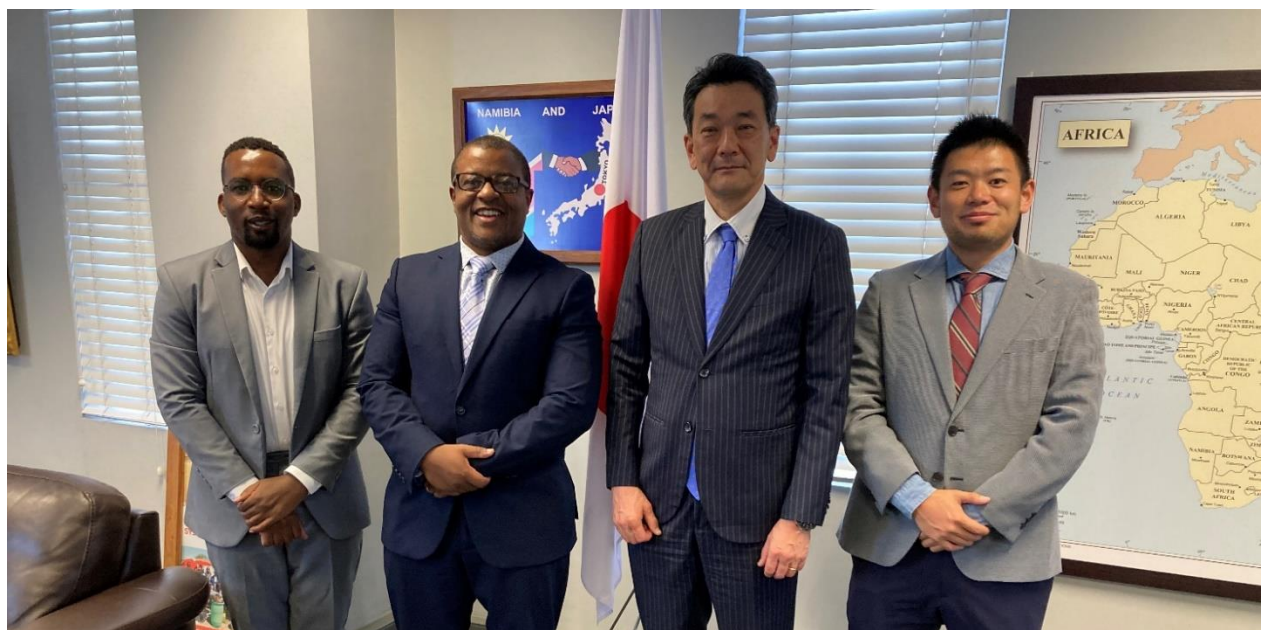
On 10 February 2025, Ambassador Asazuma received a courtesy visit from Mr. Tiwonge Machiwenyika, Acting Country Director of WFP Namibia.
