

Drought Relief Post-Distribution Monitoring visit in Kunene Region with World Food Program (WFP) (26 February 2025)

On 26 February 2025, Ambassador Asazuma visited Kunene Region on a Post-Distribution Monitoring Visit with WFP Namibia Acting Country Director Tiwonge Machiwenyika. Ambassador Asazuma visited Farm Queen Sofia and the De Riet Settlement in the Kunene Region to assess the impact of commodity vouchers distributed by WFP funded through the Japanese Government emergency grant assistance in support of the Namibian Government's drought relief program. Japan's drought emergency assistance enabled WFP to provide food vouchers for a period of six months, benefiting 26,555 people in Kunene and Ohangwena Regions. During the visit, Ambassador Asazuma got to engage with the beneficiaries and received wide appreciation on behalf of the Japanese Government.
