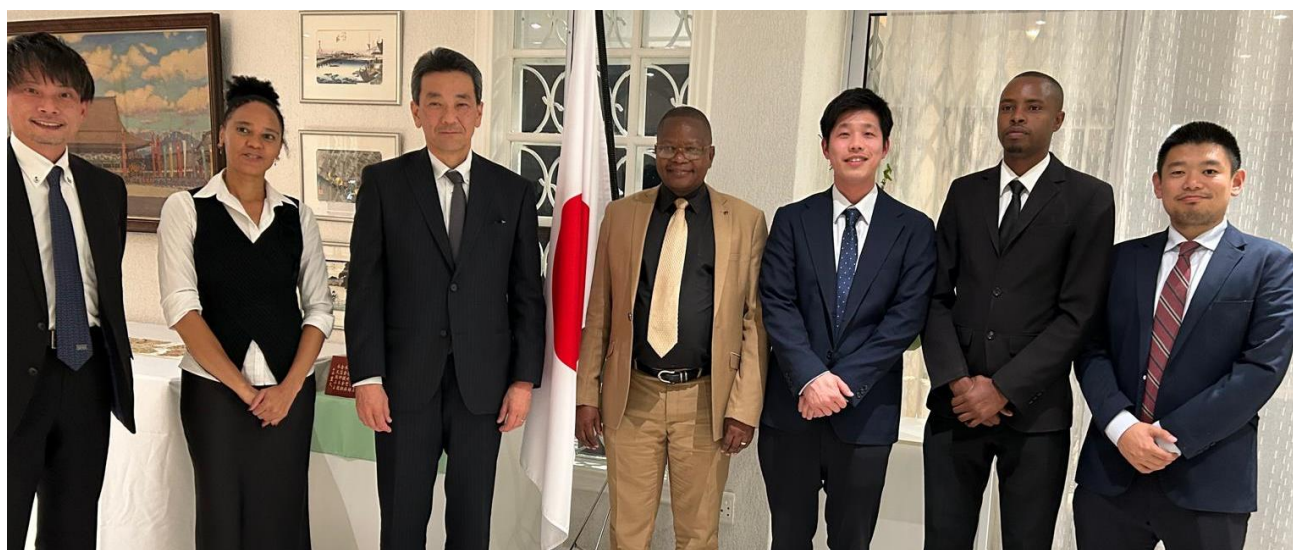


Exchange of views with stakeholders on the Launch of the Kumon Afterschool Pilot Program (23 April 2025)
