FAO JSBP Handover Ceremony for Agro-inputs in Kavango East Region (17 March 2025)

On 17 March 2025, Ambassador Asazuma officiated at a handover ceremony and project monitoring mission in the Kavango East Region where he joined the FAO, the Kavango East Regional Governor, the Kavango East Regional Council as well as the Ministry of Agriculture representation in the region.

The project titled "Emergency response to enhance resilience and mitigate climate-induced impacts on livelihoods, food and nutrition security of the most vulnerable households in Namibia" is funded by the Government of Japan under the 2023 Japan Supplementary Budget (JSB) with USD 758,916 through FAO to support the Government of Namibia and particularly the vulnerable communities that were impacted negatively by climate-induced shocks in the project focal regions of Kavango East, Kavango West and Ohangwena.

Under this project critical agro-inputs such as seeds, gardening tools, water tanks and small scale solar powered irrigation equipment, chicken, chicken feed and materials for construction of chicken houses were distributed to a targeted 1,760 farming households (approximately 8,800 people).
