

The Launch event for UNICEF' s Japan Supplementary Budget Project in FY2024/2025 @ Office of Prime Minister (18 June 2025)

On June 18, 2025, Ambassador Asazuma attended the launch event of the Japan Supplementary Budget Project in FY2024/2025 titled “Systems strengthening and enabling environments from the Impact of Natural Disasters and Disease Outbreak affecting women and children to resilience through sustainable and improved Child Survival Development in Namibia,” implemented by UNICEF.

This support package was officially handed over to the Namibian government in the presence of Prime Minister, Rt. Hon. Dr. Elijah Ngurare, Prime Minister and Hon. Sankwasa James Sankwasa, Minister of Urban and Rural Development. The programme aims to provide food and nutrition support packages for mothers and children, as well as implement WASH (Water, Sanitation and Hygiene) activities, particularly in regions most severely affected by drought. Since February of this year, UNICEF has been implementing the programme with the support of a contribution from the Government of Japan amounting to USD 450,000 (approximately NAD 8,632,350).
