

Official Handover Ceremony of Three Ambulance Trucks Donated by Japan to the Ministry of Health and Social Services in Namibia (4 September 2025)

On September 4, 2025, the Embassy of Japan represented by Mr. Noriaki Sadamoto, Charge d'Affaires ad interim officiated at the handover of 3 Ambulance Trucks to the Ministry of Health and Social Services represented by the Honorable Minister Dr. Esperance Luvindao. The Ambulances have a combined total value of NAD 9 million (JPY 76,8 million) which is part of the Japanese Grant Aid for the Economic and Social Development Programme to the Government of the Republic of Namibia in FY2020, which total value is 300 million Japanese yen of which other medical equipment was already distributed to 17 Namibian hospitals in 2022.
