

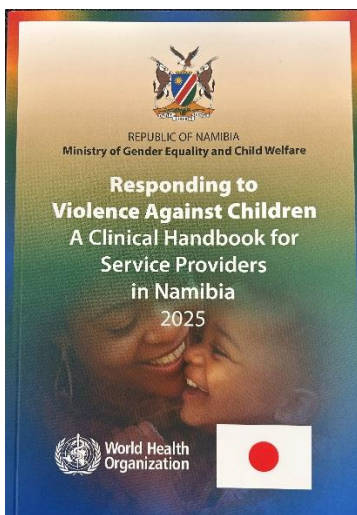
Commemoration of the Day of the Namibian Child (26 September 2025)
