

Joint Field Visit and Site Inspection to Kunene Region with UNICEF (10 - 12 November 2025)

From 10 to 12 November 2025, Ambassador Asazuma participated in Joint field visit to Kunene region and handover ceremony for WASH items provided by the Japan Supplementary Budget with Mr. Samuel Ocran who is a representative of UNICEF Namibia. This project is implemented by UNICEF in collaborate with the Ministry of Health and Social Services of the Republic of Namibia and provided approximately 2,200 WASH items to targeted areas. In this visit, Ambassador Asazuma visited Oukongo Combined School, Otjimuhaka elementary school and Otjimuhaka clinic. In these areas, the access to hygiene facility is still challenging and WASH items are expected to improve health and hygiene situation. Especially in Omutihaka clinic, maternal and child health handbook was already introduced. During the checkup, WASH items were distributed to households and guidance on their use was provided. Through this site inspection, they showed appreciation and emphasized the importance of hygiene environment improvement and hand washing practices
