

Ambassador Asazuma's visit to Zambezi Vocational Training Centre (20 February 2026)

On 20 February 2026, Ambassador Asazuma visited the Zambezi Vocational Training Centre to follow up on the utilization status of vocational training equipment handed over in 2024 (worth 300 million Japanese yen / approximately 42 million Namibian dollars).

At the 7th Tokyo International Conference on African Development (TICAD VII) held in 2019, the late Prime Minister Abe and the late President Dr. Hage Geingob, expressed their intention to strengthen bilateral relations. At that time, the late Prime Minister Abe announced support for Namibia's vocational training.

Former Namibian Ambassador to Japan, Ambassador Morven M. Luswenyo, who is from Zambezi Region, accompanied the visit and, together with Ambassador Asazuma, confirmed the utilization status of the donated equipment.
