

GGP Donated Vehicles and Equipment Handover Ceremony at the University of Namibia in the Khomas Region (25 March 2026)

On 25 March 2026, Ambassador Asazuma officiated at a Grassroots/Human Security Grant Aid Program (GGP) funded handover ceremony together with the H.E. Dr. Nangolo Mbumba, 4th President of the Republic of Namibia and Chancellor of the University of Namibia (UNAM), where Reconditioned Vehicles and Equipment for Medical, Welfare and Firefighting were donated to the University of Namibia.

The donation adds to the ever growing collaboration between the Embassy of Japan–UNAM and the Japan–Namibia bilateral relations.

THE GGP Project valued at USD72,906 for the provision of reconditioned vehicles and equipment for medical, welfare and firefighting to the University of Namibia.

Donated items included: a Reconditioned Mobile Clinic, a Reconditioned Disabled Persons' Medical Emergency Vehicle, a Reconditioned Fire Truck, 5 Fire Fighting Protective Clothing, 5 Hospital Beds, and 5 Wheelchairs.

The donation of three vehicles was made possible with the cooperation of the Society for Promotion of Japanese Diplomacy (SPJD), and the price of the three vehicles is not included in the total amount of the GGP project.
