

Inspection of donated Ambulances at Swakopmund, Erongo Region (31 March 2026)

On 31 March 2026, Dr. Masatoshi Mihara, the medical attached of the Embassy of Japan in Namibia conducted an inspection of donated ambulances in Swakopmund, Erongo Region. The ambulances were donated by Kawasaki City in Kanagawa Prefecture and Daito-Shijonawate Fire Department in Osaka Prefecture under the Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP) in FY2020. The donation was made possible with the cooperation of the Society for Promotion of Japanese Diplomacy (SPJD)

The two ambulances were handed over in September 2021. Almost five years have passed since their introduction. Even now, they remain in daily active use and continue to contribute to enhancing the city's capacity to respond to emergency medical situations.
