

Courtesy Call to Khorixas Town Council (15 July 2026)

On 15 July 2026, Ambassador Asazuuma, together with Mr. Samuel Kweku Ocran, UNICEF Country Representative in Namibia, made a joint visit to Khorixas town in the Kunene Region and paid a courtesy call on the Khorixas Town Council.

Kuenene Region, which includes Khorixas, is one of target regions for the project “Strengthening health system and community capacity to reduce incidence, impact and severity of public health emergencies in the affected communities in Namibia,” currently being implemented by UNICEF with funding from the Japanese government’s Supplementary Budget.
